**Remarks**: *Smythea lanceata* is regarded as a 'critically endangered' species in Singapore (Chong et al., 2009). The species was reported from the Kranji Nature Trail in August 2011 by Yeo (2013). It was first found at Mandai mangroves in November 2014, during a survey by staff of the Sungei Buloh Wetland Reserve. The distinctive zigzag stem (Fig. 4) and flowers (Fig. 2) are identical to those depicted in Primavera & Sadaba (2012).
