

Stellar rockskipper blenny at Big Sister Island

Subject: Stellar rockskipper blenny, *Entomacrodus lighti* (Teleostei: Blennidae).

Subjects identified by: Kelvin K. P. Lim.

Location, date and time: Singapore Straits, reef flat at Big Sister Island; 15 December 2012; 0727 hrs.

Habitat: Coral reef, intertidal zone.

Observer: Ron K. H. Yeo.

Observation: An example of about 10 cm total length was observed on the substrate at low tide.

Remarks: The stellar rockskipper is distributed along the tropical coast of China southwards to Thailand and Singapore (Allen & Erdmann, 2012: 823). It is uncommonly met with in Singapore waters.
