

**HISTORY, DATES OF PUBLICATION AND BIBLIOGRAPHY
OF THE BULLETIN OF THE RAFFLES MUSEUM,
BULLETIN OF THE NATIONAL MUSEUM AND
THE RAFFLES BULLETIN OF ZOOLOGY
(1928 - 1993)**

ABSTRACT. - The history of the BULLETIN OF THE RAFFLES MUSEUM (also known as the BULLETIN OF THE NATIONAL MUSEUM), now published as THE RAFFLES BULLETIN OF ZOOLOGY, is briefly reviewed, and the dates of publication of all the parts, numbers and volumes are listed. The journal, first started in 1928, is now in its 65th year and has published almost 500 papers, mainly on Southeast Asian and especially Malayan zoology. The complete bibliography is presented in Volume and Year, Subject, and Author indices.

INTRODUCTION

In September 1928, the Raffles Museum published the first issue of the BULLETIN OF THE RAFFLES MUSEUM, a journal dedicated mainly to the study of zoology and natural history of Malaya. Although undergoing several changes in name, the journal has nevertheless persisted over the last 65 years through many turbulent changes, including the dissolution of the museum as a zoological institute.

The director of the Raffles Museum made the following comments when the journal was first published in 1928: "Hitherto the Museum had had no publication of its own and until recent years the want of one was perhaps not felt. But of late the output of papers prepared by the staff and by others on its collections has increased considerably: and, although the Museum has been able gratefully to avail itself of the hospitality offered by a number of Societies and Institutions which have placed space in their publications at its disposal, yet, welcome as this hospitality - which is one that is hoped still to make use of occasionally - has been, it nevertheless suffered from two drawbacks. The one was a lack of promptness in publication: the other drawback was that the Raffles Museum was without a means to make some return to the numerous Museums, Institutions and Societies which present it with their publications. The Bulletin will be published as material is available; each number will be complete in itself and will have its own pagination: but it is intended whenever sufficient numbers to form a volume a reasonable size have been produced to issue a title-page, table of contents and index." (Boden Kloss, 1929: 3)

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Boden Kloss' rationale for a journal on Malayan zoology remains true to this day. Over the last 65 years, the BULLETIN OF THE RAFFLES MUSEUM has changed its title and format many times, reflecting the political changes which have occurred in Singapore. With the independence of Malaysia (and for a short time, the state of Singapore), and subsequent independence of Singapore as a separate nation, the name of the museum, and the journal, have also changed. In 1970, the now renamed National Museum of Singapore decided on a drastic policy change, and the museum now directed its energies towards Art, History and Ethnology (Alfred, 1988; Liu, 1988). The large zoological collections, after a period of uncertainty, were eventually transferred to the then University of Singapore in 1972. This became the Zoological Reference Collection (see Sharma, 1988; Yang, 1988, 1990). With the merger of the University of Singapore and Nanyang University into a national university in 1980, the Zoological Reference Collection eventually became part of the Department of Zoology, National University of Singapore (see Yang, 1990).

With the exception of two gaps (one during the war years, and another during the zoological collection's transition years of 1972-1988), the journal has been regularly published, and almost 500 papers on various aspects of Southeast Asian zoology have been disseminated. It was thus felt that the time was appropriate to provide a short review of the journal and a synopsis of its contents during its 65 years from 1928 to 1993. This bibliography, together with that of the Malayan Nature Journal (Kiew & Lyons, 1992), will provide a quick means of becoming familiar with the zoological literature in the region, particularly Malaya.

The various titles of the journal (henceforth referred to as the BULLETIN) will be listed. The dates of publication and changes in format of the BULLETIN will be listed and discussed, and several discrepancies explained. Finally, all the papers published in the BULLETIN between 1928 and 1993 will be bibliographically arranged in a three sections by issue, topic and author.

TITLE OF THE BULLETIN

The title of the BULLETIN has changed several times over the years. The names used, together with the recommended abbreviation (in parenthesis, in italics), are as follows:

DATES OF PUBLICATION OF PARTS, NUMBERS AND VOLUMES

Between 1928 and 1970, the BULLETIN was issued in numbers, with each number containing individual papers. In a few cases, the whole number constituted of only one paper (e.g. a monograph). As the aim was to publish papers as and when enough could be received to form a number, the numbers were not published annually or even biennially. In some cases (e.g. 1939), there were no numbers for a particular year, but in others (e.g. 1950) there were up to three numbers a year. In most cases, only the month and year of publication was indicated. In such cases, the day of publication should be regarded as the last day of the month as most of the numbers or volumes were available only then. Between 1965 and 1970 (as the BULLETIN OF THE NATIONAL MUSEUM), each number was issued in separate parts, each with its own publication date. From 1988 onwards (as THE RAFFLES BULLETIN OF ZOOLOGY), the BULLETIN was issued as volumes, each with at least two numbers. Each number, with its own publication date, usually contains a number of received papers. The numbers of the BULLETIN OF THE RAFFLES MUSEUM and BULLETIN OF THE NATIONAL MUSEUM are equivalent to the volume numbers of THE RAFFLES BULLETIN OF ZOOLOGY, with the numbers running consecutively.

There are two discrepancies which should be noted (marked by asterisks (*) in the list below). Number 26 (pp. 5-203) was published in February 1961 but numbers 27, 28 and 29 were published in October 1956, December 1956 and August 1960 respectively. That is, even though numbers 27-29 had dates of publications (1956-1960) preceding that of number 26 (1961), the latter had a smaller publication number. Number 26 was originally sent to the printers for publication before numbers 27 to 29, but because a large paper it contained was suddenly pulled out, the number was held back and never printed on schedule. Meanwhile, the papers for numbers 27 and 28, under the editorship of Mr. Michael Tweedie, had already been cleared, sent to press and printed. The same was true of number 28, which was a monograph edited by Dr. Carl Gibson-Hill. It was during this time also that Tweedie retired, and Gibson-Hill was promoted to the directorship of the museum. The editorship for the troubled and still unprinted number 26 was eventually passed to the succeeding curator of zoology, Mr. Eric Alfred in 1957. After obtaining enough papers, number 26 was eventually published in 1961, six years behind schedule. The bound volume of the BULLETIN containing numbers 26 to 29 in the museum contains a typed contents page which noted that "Chronologically No. 26 follows No. 29 and was numbered 26 to fill the gap in the series". The papers in number 26 should thus remain dated as February 1961, although it was supposed to have been published in 1955.

Because of the problems of time wasted in waiting to accumulate sufficient papers to justify one number, the BULLETIN changed its format for number 33. Instead of waiting for all the papers to accumulate, submitted papers were published as and when they were received. Number 33 eventually contained 16 parts, dating from March 1965 to 28 February 1967 (see list below). During this period however, a good number of papers were received as a result of an expedition to the islands of Pulau Tioman and Pulau Tulai off eastern Malaysia. Although number 33 was not yet complete at the time, the editors had an additional complete volume (number 34) published in March 1966 to report specifically on the expedition's findings.

HOW TO USE THE BIBLIOGRAPHY

A total of 496 articles have been published in the Raffles Bulletin of Zoology and its predecessors, the Bulletin of the Raffles Museum and the Bulletin of the National Museum, over the past 65 years. All these articles are listed in this bibliography, in each of three sections which appear in the following order: the Volume and Year Index, the Subject Index and the Author Index. The citations provided in each section is complete and no cross referencing is necessary.

Throughout the bibliography, the three names of the journal are abbreviated as follows:

BRM : Bulletin of the Raffles Museum
BNM : Bulletin of the National Museum
RBZ : The Raffles Bulletin of Zoology

The first section, the Volume and Year Index, lists articles chronologically. The papers published in that volume are listed below, in the original order in which they appeared. These citations provide the names of the author(s), title and the page numbers only. The only exception is BNM No. 33 which consists of 16 parts over the years 1965 to 1967. The citation for this particular issue includes the year and part number as well.

The second section, the Subject Index, groups articles based on the topic addressed. Some citations were relevant to more than one heading, and are thus repeated in the index accordingly. Under each heading, the articles are first arranged alphabetically, and then chronologically.

The Author Index is an alphabetical listing of all articles by author. Papers by the same author are chronologically sorted. Second and third authors are included, but the reader is referred to the senior author for the complete citation.
