New Singapore record of the nudibranch, Goniobranchus trimarginatus

Subject: Goniobranchus trimarginatus. (Mollusca: Gastropoda: Chromodorididae).

Subject identified by: Toh Chay Hoon.

Location, date and time: Singapore Strait, off Pulau Hantu; 30 December 2018; around 2100 hrs.

Habitat: Marine. Coral reef. Under a jetty at about 9 m depth.

Observer: Toh Chay Hoon.

Observation: One example of about 1 cm total length (see accompanying picture showing a dorsal view with head pointing to the right) was observed crawling on the silty substrate.

Remarks: The photographed individual resembles *Goniobranchus trimarginatus* illustrated in Gosliner et al. (2018: 154). As this species is not listed by Tan & Woo (2010), it is likely to be new record for Singapore.
