

## Kacang-kacang at Kranji

**Subjects:** Kacang-kacang, *Aegiceras corniculatum* (Magnoliophyta: Myrsinaceae).

**Subjects identified by:** Contributor.

**Location, date and time:** Singapore Island, Kranji Nature Trail, mangrove forest on landward side; 2 April 2011; 1605 hrs.

**Habitat:** Mangrove.

**Observer:** Contributor.

**Observation:** Two young plants, about 1 m tall, were identified in the mangrove forest on the landward side.

**Remarks:** The kacang-kacang is an endangered tree in Singapore (Chong et al., 2009). During subsequent trips to the Kranji Nature Trail mangrove forest on 5 April 2011 and 19 August 2011, six mature plants with flowers and fruits were discovered.
