

Berembang at Kranji

Subject: Berembang, *Sonneratia caseolaris* (Magnoliophyta: Lythraceae).

Subject identified by: Contributor.

Location, date and time: Singapore Island, Kranji Nature Trail, mangrove forest on landward side; 30 December 2010; 1120 hrs.

Habitat: Back mangrove.

Observer: Contributor.

Observation: One mature tree, about 10 m tall, was seen at the back mangrove.

Remarks: The berembang is a critically endangered true mangrove species in Singapore (Chong et al., 2009).
