Berembang at Berlayar Creek

Subject: Berembang, *Sonneratia caseolaris* (Magnoliophyta: Lythraceae).

Subject identified by: Contributor.

Location, date and time: Singapore Island, Berlayar Creek; 16 January 2012; 1445 hrs.

Habitat: Small mangrove-lined stream.

Observer: Contributor.

Observation: One mature tree, about 7 m tall, was seen growing on the stream bank.

Remarks: *Sonneratia caseolaris* is considered a critically endangered true mangrove species in Singapore (Chong et al., 2009).
