

Greenhouse frog at Dairy Farm

Subject: Greenhouse frog, *Eleutherodactylus planirostris* (Amphibia; Anura; Eleutherodactylidae)

Subject identified by: Law Ing Sind.

Location, date and time: Singapore Island, Dairy Farm Nature Park, Wallace Education Centre; 18 November 2017; around 2045 hrs.

Habitat: Secondary forest adjacent to urban parkland.

Observers: Abel Yeo & Lena Chow.

Observation: A single individual of about 1.5 cm snout-vent length was observed amongst the leaf litter on the forest floor (see accompanying picture). No other individuals were detected.

Remarks: The greenhouse frog was first detected in Singapore at Sembawang (Groenewoud & Law, 2016) and subsequently in the Clementi woods area (Tay et al., 2017). This is the third published record of this non-native amphibian in Singapore.
