Biodiversity Record: Spotted box crab at Changi Beach

Subject: Spotted box crab, Calappa philargius (Crustacea: Decapoda: Brachyura: Calappidae).

Subject identified by: Cheong Yi Loong Benny.

Location, date and time: Singapore Island, Changi Beach; 17 November 2024; around 1745 hrs.

Habitat: Estuarine shore. Seagrass meadow at intertidal zone, exposed during late afternoon low tide.

Observer: Cheong Yi Loong Benny.

Observation: One example of about 8 cm carapace width (Figs. 1, 2) was found fully exposed on the sand. The crab initially remained still when approached, allowing photographs to be obtained. Subsequently, it bubbled and spewed water through its mouth, then burrowed into the sand and disappeared from the observer's view. The encounter took place hours after a thunderstorm, under partial sunny conditions.

Remarks: The spotted box crab is listed as 'Near Threatened' in the third edition of the Singapore Red Data Book (Mendoza et al., 2024). This species is nocturnal and typically seen at night, preferring to hide in the sand in the day (Tan, 2019). It, therefore, seems unusual to see one exposed in daylight. The species was last recorded locally at Lazarus Island (Lee, 2024).
